## No charge for acceptable items (working or not) ---- basically, anything that has a cord or battery

Computers and laptops, LCD Monitors, Scanners & Fax Machines, Keyboards, Stoves, Microwaves, and Ovens, Medical & Lab Equipment, DVR, Cable, and Satellite Boxes, Hard Drives & Solid State Drives, VCR, DVD, and Blu Ray Players, Cell Phones & Tablets, Kitchen Appliances, Washers & Dryers, Lawn & Garden (Oil and Fuel Removed), Servers, Switches, and Networking.

## Fees (cash or check only) for the following Items:

CRT TV's 26" and smaller \$30 each LED/LCD/Plasma TV's - \$20 each CRT Monitors - \$5 each Freon Containing Items - \$10 each

CRT TV's 27" and Larger - \$50 each Console/Rear Projection TV's - \$50 each Printers/Copiers/MFP's - \$5 each

## **Event** is open to the public.

EXCEPTIONS: Alkaline and Single Use Lithium Batteries, Any Chemical or Liquid, CD's, DVD's VHS, and Floppy Media, Any Tank or Cylinder, Hazardous Materials, PCB Containing Ballast, Smoke Detectors, Exit Signs, Light Bulbs, Fluorescent Tubes, Mattresses, Wooden Furniture. All lawn and garden equipment must have fuel and oil properly drained before collection.

This event is funded by a grant from Saint Louis County Department of Public Health utilizing County landfill surcharge funds.

Midwest Recycling is registered with the EPA, R2 Nationally Certified, and is Level 4 Certified with the Missouri Department of Natural Resources. Midwest Recycling has a zero-landfill policy. This event is open to Marlborough residents and non-residents, schools, churches, and businesses.
